SYNOPSIS OF UPCOMING FILMS

BEAUTY & THE BEAST (1991-G) 1 hr. 24 min. Animation/Family/Fantasy. *"It's got storytelling vigor and clarity, bright, eclectic animation, and a frisky musical wit."* An arrogant young prince (Robby Benson) and his castle's servants fall under the spell of a wicked enchantress, who turns him into the hideous Beast until he learns to love and be loved in return. The spirited, headstrong village girl Belle (Paige O'Hara) enters the Beast's castle after he imprisons her father Maurice (Rex Everhart). With the help of his enchanted servants, including the matronly Mrs. Potts (Angela Lansbury), Belle begins to draw the cold-hearted Beast out of his isolation.

CHAMPIONS (2023-PG-13) 2 hr. 4 min. Comedy/Drama/Sport. *"Wholesome and commendable. These fresh screen faces ooze charisma and have wonderful comic timing."* Woody Harrelson stars in the hilarious and heartwarming story of a former minor-league basketball coach who, after a series of missteps, is ordered by the court to manage a team of players with intellectual disabilities. He soon realizes that despite his doubts, together, this team can go further than they ever imagined.

FERRIS BUELLER'S DAY OFF (1986-PG-13) 1 hr. 43 min. Comedy. *"Ferris Bueller's Day Off still works like a cure to stave the blues away"* Ferris Bueller (Matthew Broderick) has an uncanny skill at cutting classes and getting away with it. Intending to make one last duck-out before graduation, Ferris calls in sick, "borrows" a Ferrari, and embarks on a one-day journey through the streets of Chicago. On Ferris' trail is high school principal Rooney (Jeffrey Jones), determined to catch him in the act.

MISSING (2023-PG-13) 1 hr. 51 min. Drama/Thriller. *“Missing is another stellar effort at a Screenlife thriller that shows that ingenuity in storytelling can make well-worn narratives feel shiny and new again. Recommended.”* When her mother (Nia Long) disappears while on vacation in Colombia with her new boyfriend, June's (Storm Reid) search for answers is hindered by international red tape. Stuck thousands of miles away in Los Angeles, June creatively uses all the latest technology at her fingertips to try and find her before it's too late. But as she digs deeper, her digital sleuthing raises more questions than answers... and when June unravels secrets about her mom, she discovers that she never really knew her at all.

MOVING ON (2022-R) 1 hr. 25 min. Comedy. *“Fonda and Tomlin are as good as they have ever been and ‘Moving On’ proves itself a powerful rumination on the strength it takes to age—mentally, physically, and economically.”* Jane Fonda and Lily Tomlin star as estranged friends who reunite to seek revenge on the petulant widower (Malcolm McDowell) of their recently deceased best friend. Along the way, Fonda's character reunites with her great love (Richard Roundtree) as each woman learns to make peace with the past and each other.

SAFETY LAST! (1923) 1 hr. 14 min. Action/Comedy/Thriller. Stars silent film comedian Harold Lloyd as a small-town bumpkin trying to make it in the big city. Employed as a lowly department-store clerk, he comes up with a wild publicity stunt to draw attention to the store, resulting his attempt at an incredible feat of derring-do. Laugh-out-loud funny and jaw-dropping in equal measure, Safety Last! Will be accompanied live with the original 1923 orchestral score performed by The Paragon Ragtime Orchestra.

SCREAM VI (2023-R) 2 hr. 2 min. Horror/Mystery/Thriller. *“Scream VI shows there’s still life in this series, and now that a new generation has been given control of the story, I’m curious to see where things go next.”* Following the latest Ghostface killings, the four survivors leave Woodsboro behind and start a fresh chapter.

SHREK (2001-PG) 1 hr. 30 min. Animation/Adventure/Comedy. *“Shrek is alive, and with dark, sly and absolutely hilarious irreverence lampooning every once-sacred characteristic of the nursery kingdom. Shrek is a subversive joy...”* Once upon a time, in a far away swamp, there lived an ogre named Shrek (Mike Myers) whose precious solitude is suddenly shattered by an invasion of annoying fairy tale characters. They were all banished from their kingdom by the evil Lord Farquaad (John Lithgow). Determined to save their home -- not to mention his -- Shrek cuts a deal with Farquaad and sets out to rescue Princess Fiona (Cameron Diaz) to be Farquaad's bride. Rescuing the Princess may be small compared to her deep, dark secret.

THE LOST KING (2022-PG-13) 1 hr. 48 min. Comedy/Drama. *“Stephen Frears gives us something really comforting, sweet, solid and sincere.”* In this inspiring true story, amateur historian Philippa Langley believes she has made the archeological find of the century: the lost burial site of King Richard III. She takes on Britain's most eminent historians, forcing them to rethink the legacy of one of the most controversial rulers in English history.
