SYNOPSIS OF UPCOMING FILMS

THE APARTMENT (1960 – NR) 2 hrs. 5 min. Dark Comedy. A Manhattan insurance clerk tries to rise in his company by letting its executives use his apartment for trysts, but office politics and his own romantic hopes complicate matters.

DAVID (2025 – PG) 1 hr. 49 min. Adventure. From his mother's songs to his clash with Goliath, David's journey from humble shepherd to anointed king tests the limits of faith, courage, and love--culminating in a battle for the soul of a kingdom.

DISCLOSURE DAY (2026 – PG-13) 2 hrs. 25 min. Sci-Fi. If you found out we weren't alone, if someone showed you, proved it to you, would that frighten you?

FIELD OF DREAMS (1989 – PG) 1 hr. 47 min. Baseball/Family. Iowa farmer Ray Kinsella is inspired by a voice he can't ignore to pursue a dream he can hardly believe. Supported by his wife, Ray begins the quest by turning his ordinary cornfield into a place where dreams can come true.

THE INVITE (2026 – R) 1 hr. 47 min. Comedy. Joe and Angela's marriage is on thin ice. When they invite their enigmatic upstairs neighbors for a dinner party, the night spirals into unexpected places.

LABYRINTH (1986 – PG) 1hr. 41 min. Fantasy. Teenage Sarah journeys through a maze to save her baby brother from the Goblin King.

MASTERS OF THE UNIVERSE (2026 – PG-13) 2 hrs. 20 min. Adventure. A young man on Earth discovers a fabulous secret legacy as the prince of an alien planet, and must recover a magic sword and return home to protect his kingdom.

MINIONS & MONSTERS (2026 – PG) 1 hr. 30 min. Animation. Follows the Minions in 1920s Hollywood as they search for frightening creatures for their monster movie, partner with a green creature, and must save the planet after unleashing monsters.

MOONSTRUCK (1987 – PG) 1 hr. 42 min. Romantic Comedy. Loretta Castorini, a bookkeeper from Brooklyn, New York, finds herself in a difficult situation when she falls for the brother of the man she has agreed to marry.

MUPPET TREASURE ISLAND (1996 – G) 1 hr. 39 min. Sea Adventure. The Muppets set sail in search of treasure, with Jim Hawkins and Long John Silver.

NATIONAL LAMPOON'S VACATION (1983 – R) 1 hr. 38 min. Comedy. The Griswold family's cross-country drive in their brand new Wagon Family Truckster to the Walley World theme park in California proves to be much more arduous than they ever anticipated.

PIRATES OF THE CARIBBEAN (2003 – PG-13) 2 hrs. 23 min. Adventure. An intrepid blacksmith teams up with an eccentric pirate captain to save his love from an undead pirate crew.

POWER BALLAD (2026 – R) 1 hr. 38 min. Comedy. Rick, a washed-up wedding singer, and Danny, a fading boy band star, bond over music and a late-night jam session. When Danny turns Rick's song into a hit, Rick sets out to reclaim the recognition he believes he deserves.

TANGLED (2010 – PG) 1 hr. 40 min. Family. The magically long-haired Rapunzel has spent her entire life in a tower, but now that a runaway thief has stumbled upon her, she is about to discover the world for the first time, and who she really is.

WHAT'S UP, DOC? (1972 – G) 1 hr. 34 min. Comedy. The accidental mix-up of four identical plaid overnight bags leads to a series of increasingly wild and wacky situations.

WICKED (2024 – PG) 2 hrs. 40 min. Fairy Tale. Elphaba, a young woman ridiculed for her green skin, and Galinda, a popular girl, become friends at Shiz University in the Land of Oz. After an encounter with the Wonderful Wizard of Oz, their friendship reaches a crossroads.
